## A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



### DEAR FRIENDS,

As I reflect on my first year as Board President and 17th year as a volunteer of the United Way of Naugatuck and Beacon Falls, I find myself proud of what this organization has been able to accomplish in one year. Although being the smallest United Way in the State of Connecticut, we have been able to accomplish many big things! This is all due to an extraordinary team of volunteers, partner agencies, sponsors, and employees that make up our organization. Together we all share the commitment of improving the communities of Naugatuck and Beacon Falls. This year we increased donors by establishing the Tocqueville Society which already has 11 donors, we've added 19 new members

to the Salem Society, and have 10 members that have increased their donations by 10% or more! Each year, I find myself more amazed at the amount of volunteers, volunteer hours, and financial commitment that goes towards making each annual campaign a success. It is inspiring, humbling, and a privilege to be a part of.

With the leadership of Co-Chairs Donna Andrew and John McCormack, we have been able to raise funds through employee campaigns, fundraising events, and special donors. I would like to extend my sincerest gratitude to this duo. Their willingness, dedication, and teamwork has led our 2021 campaign to success. **I am proud to report that we have absolutely crushed our 2021 campaign goal of \$415,000!**

Funds raised are carefully allocated throughout various partner agencies. This is done through our Allocations Committee which is comprised of several community leaders and professionals and led by Stephen Pretto. Together with Stephen's leadership and guidance, they review all funding applications thoroughly and thoughtfully. They then meet with the agencies as part of the application process and determine funding amounts to each program. I would like to personally thank Stephen and his team. Their dedication to our community, attention to detail, and desire to help is unmeasurable. It is because of this committee that our United Way is able to be as efficient and effective as we are with funding. Thank you.

I would like to thank Marylou Cunningham and the Marketing committee for their commitment and work. They do an awesome job in creating articles profiling volunteers, donors, and partner agencies. This committee keeps our United Way in the forefront of our communities by utilizing print media, and social media, also broadening our reach when searching for new volunteers, donors, and potential new partner agencies. Without this team of dedicated and talented individuals, our United Way would not have such a voice that it does. Thank you.

The United Way of Naugatuck and Beacon Falls has a society which exists to recognize its donors who generously donate at least \$1,000 annually. In this 2021

campaign, with the leadership of Salem Society Chair Rebecca Zandvliet, the United Way has been able to increase Salem Society donors by 19 new members! Thank you Rebecca, and all who make up the Salem Society. Your financial commitment to our communities has a substantial impact! Thank you.

Through the leadership of Tocqueville Society Chair David Rotatori and as part of the 2021 campaign, our United Way has created the Tocqueville Society. In 2021-2022, the United Way through the leadership of Bob Dickson, has established a Strategic Planning committee. The United Way had a very successful year of special events. These special events give the United Way an ability to connect with the people of our community, while raising campaign dollars in unique and fun ways. Here is a recap of this year's events:

- The very popular Salem Bus Trip, thanks to Donna Andrew
- Gobble 'Til You Wobble, organized by Kimberly Santulli and Courtney Ligi
- The 12th Annual Festival of Trees which returned to Ion Bank and raised over \$12,000!

The United Way is also proud to support Connecticut Foodshare's Mobile Food Pantry that visits our community every month. We assist in providing volunteers to help with distribution and to assist the elderly and other participants requiring assistance during the truck visits.

Please join me in especially thanking both Executive Director Lisa Shappy and Finance Director Beth Mongelluzzo for their continued commitment, leadership, and for being such incredible role models in our community.

## MARY CONNOLLY COMMUNITY CARING AWARD

In 2013, he was named Guest of Honor at the New York Minor Board of Greater New York for his commitment and dedication to minor Gaelic Football. In 2014, he was named Irish Man of the Year at the annual banquet of the New Haven Gaelic Football & Hurling Club.

John is able to spend time volunteering thanks to the dedication and sacrifices of his State Farm teammates – Stephanie Cabral, Tamirys Dos Santos, and Jason Ruiz.

Kevin has coached American Legion Post 17 Baseball, Naugatuck High School Girls Basketball team in the offseason during Coach Keith Raczkowski tenure and was the Head Freshman Football coach for 20 years at Holy Cross High School and a varsity assistant during the same time.
